

# Fuel price report (July 2017)

**Unleaded** prices have fallen 1.7p from 116.4 ppl to 114.7 ppl. **Diesel** prices have dropped 2p from 117.4p to 115.4p. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has fallen to 0.7 ppl.

**The South East** has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 115.1 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 113.8 ppl. **The South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 116.0 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 114.3 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 111.8 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has edged up to 2.9 ppl.
