

Fuel price report (November 2017)

Unleaded prices have risen 2.2p from 118.0 ppl to 120.2 ppl. Diesel prices have gone up 2.3p from 120.3p to 122.6p. The price difference between diesel and unleaded has grown to 2.4 ppl.

The South East has recorded the highest price for **unleaded** at 120.9 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has recorded the lowest price for **unleaded** at 118.8 ppl. **The South East** has recorded the highest **diesel** price at 123.2 ppl. **Northern Ireland** has the cheapest **diesel** at 121.1 ppl.

Supermarket prices for **unleaded** now average 116.5 ppl. The gap between supermarket prices and the UK average for **unleaded** has jumped to 3.7 ppl.
